Benefits

- ◆ Nitrogen production
- ◆ Soil aeration & drainage
- ◆ Increased earthworms
- ◆ Reduces compaction
- ◆ Increased rooting in next year's crops
- ◆ Increases nutrient availability
- ◆ Reduces weeds
- ◆ Increases water & air in soil
- ◆ Reduces erosion
- ◆ Holds plant nutrients at soil surface

Planting

- ◆ Plant six weeks before killing frost (generally from August 1st to mid-September).
- ◆ For best results, spread seed by broadcast spreader over exposed soil prior to rain or irrigating sprinkler.
- ◆ Seed should not be deeper than 1/2".
- ◆ This mix will over-winter, be prepared to till into soil or spray clover before 8" tall.
- ◆ 1 pound covers 2,100 square feet.
