#### Did you know?

- Leaves of a mature tree will provide enough oxygen to keep one person breathing for a year
- One moderately-sized tree has as much cooling effect in a city as 20 average room air conditioners running 20 hours per day, cooling an individual home as much as 12 degrees on a hot day.
- An average American uses about 750 pounds of paper every year, and 95% of homes are built using wood. That means each person uses the equivalent of one 100 foot tall, 16-inch diameter, tree every year for their paper and wood project needs.
- The oldest known tree is in Methuselah grove, a bristlecone pine, almost 4,900 years old, living high in the mountains on the Nevada/California border. The exact location of the tree is kept secret by the US Forest Service to protect it.
- Well maintained trees and shrubs can increase property value by up to 14%
